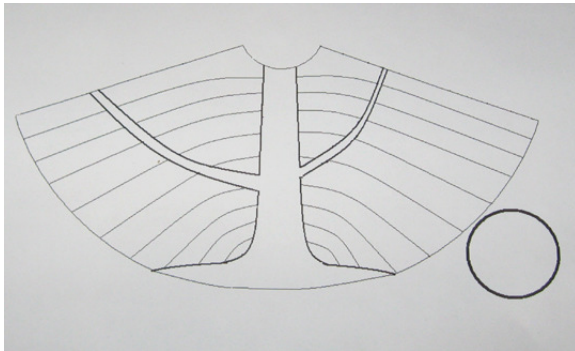


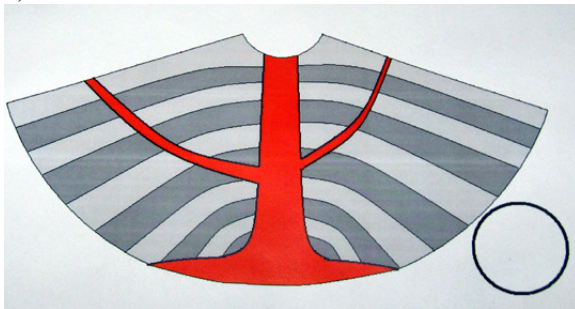
Making a Model Volcano



Locate:

- Templates. (left)
- 2 paper plates
- Glue
- Scissors
- Grass
- Stones
- Markers

1)



Color the template. Keep in mind the pyrocastic material and the lava layers should be of a dark tone. Cut-out the circle and the mountain side

2)



Place the cut-out circle in the center of one of the paper plates and trace around it with a pencil.

3)



Cut a line toward the center of the plate and cut out the traced circle.

4)



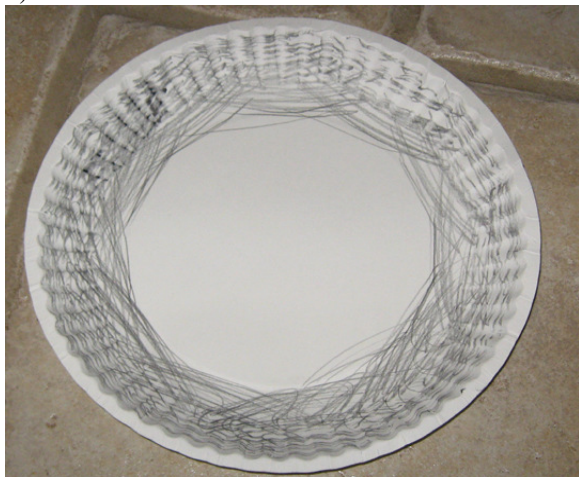
Fold over the plate forming a cone. I overlapped about 15 of the pressed in designs on the plate. Staple them together.

5)



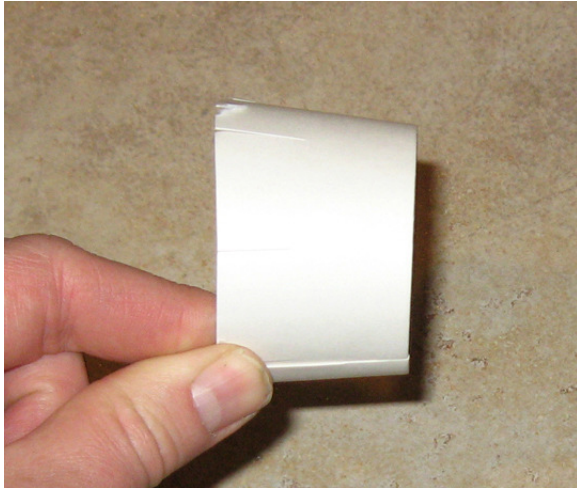
Staple the colored volcano template onto the side of your model.

6)



Earth color the base paper plate. I did a lousy job here...get creative. It should look like the crust of the Earth.

7



Cut off the bottom of a paper cup then cut several $\frac{3}{4}$ inch slits up the cup.

8)



Fold out the slits and staple the cup onto the base paper plate. Using scissors cut a small X into the bottom of the cup.

9)



Glue the cone onto the base paper plate.

10)



Coat the plain side of the cone with liberal amounts of glue.

11)



Shake the dyed sawdust onto the glue. Knock the remainder onto an empty plate.

12)



Garnish your model with stones and such.

Get ready to make it erupt!
