Classifying Data

- 1. Pair up with a partner.
- 2. Obtain a bag of mixed materials.
- 3. Pour the contents of the bag onto the table. Divide the contents into two groups based on similar characteristics.
- 4. Record the name and characteristics of each group on your chart.
- 5. Divide each of the two groups into two or three smaller groups. The items in each group must share at least one common characteristic. Give a name to each group based on the group's characteristics.
- 6. Record the characteristics of each group on your chart.
- 7. Continue to separate the items into smaller groups until each group contains only one type of item. Remember that items in a group must have characteristics that make them different from the items in the other groups.
- 8. Record the characteristics for each of the groups that you make on your chart.
- 9. Share your chart with your classmates. Communicate what characteristics you chose to distinguish each group.
